7.3 Trail Camera

The Committee will wait to see if the Video Surveillance signs curb the vandalism before purchasing cameras. There is no power supply and solar cameras would be very expensive. A resident of Vermilion Bay has indicated that they would be willing to make a donation towards cameras.

The Committee discussed putting up 'no motorized vehicles' or 'authorized vehicles only'. The Clerk-Treasurer will discuss this with Public Works.

7.4 Planters

There are two big and two small planters put on and around the rail cart near the water plant. This year the planters will be filled and maintained by the same person that plants and maintains the Municipality's flowers. The cart needs to be painted before the planters are set on it and the Pine Tree Pathways Committee will look after that job.
