5. Old Business

5.1 White Pine Trail Boardwalk Update

A Material list has been prepared. Material cost will be \$2750.00 plus tax and delivery costs. There may be lumber in the low lift shed at the Water Plant that can be used. Terry is meeting with Glen Patterson around the 2nd week of August to see if there is any special bracing required. Lloyd will contact the Municipality to see if any of this work requires a building permit. The Public Works crew will be available sometime during the week of August 22nd - 26th. The crew will help get the building materials to the building site if the Committee has not already done this and if the crew can, they will help with the building project. The Committee will also contact members from the community that expressed a willingness to help with building projects. A notice will also be put in the August Machin Messenger for students looking for high school volunteer hours to contact the Committee.

5.2 Sliding Hill Issues Update

Authorized Vehicles Only signs have been placed at the board walks to persuade people not to ride dirt bikes/4-wheelers on the board walk.

Public Works has received the granite blocks to be placed at VBay Dock, the boulders that are at the dock now will be taken to the sliding hill and placed in such a way that vehicles cannot pass. Hopefully preventing any more damage from vehicles being driven up the hill.

6. New Business

6.1 Signage on Katimavik Trail

More Trans Canada Trail signs need to be put up, but may not be able to order these signs anymore. There used to be write-ups along the trail on topics relating to the trail/area. Judy spoke with the owners of the Fort to see if they still have the write-ups so they can once again be placed along the trail. Joanne also offered to do some write-ups of local vegetation and of the history of certain sites like the Fire Tower that was behind the Fort.

Nick Sourisseau left 4 pieces of acrylic plastic to Pine Tree Pathways which could be used to protect the write-ups.
